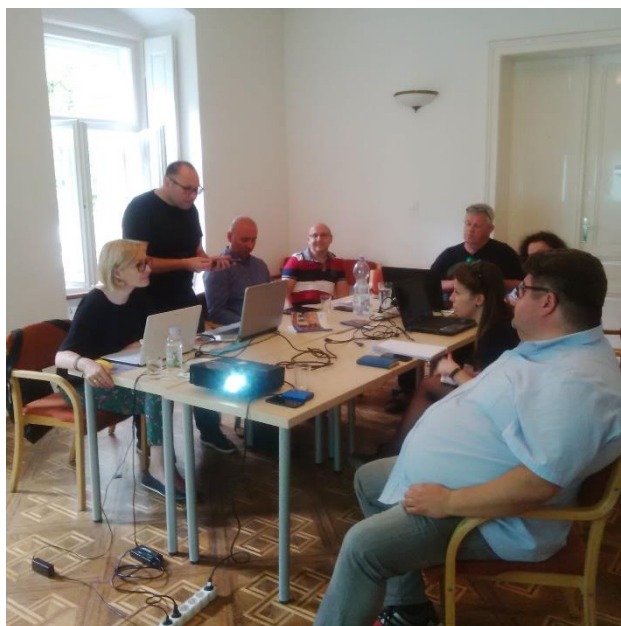

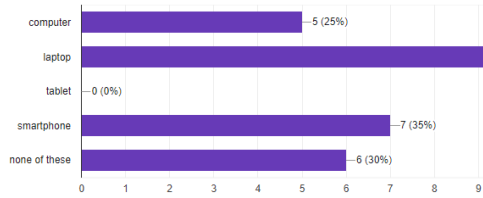

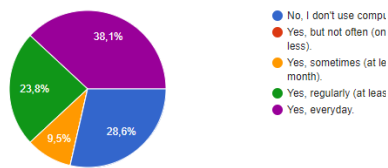
What kind of tools do you use? (You can choose more options)

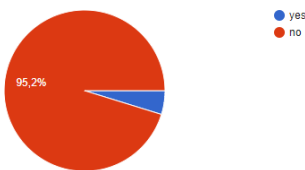
Do you use a computer (at home or in a public place)? If yes, how

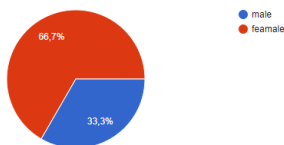

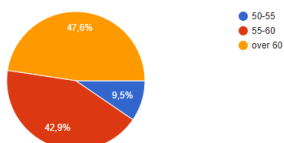
Gender

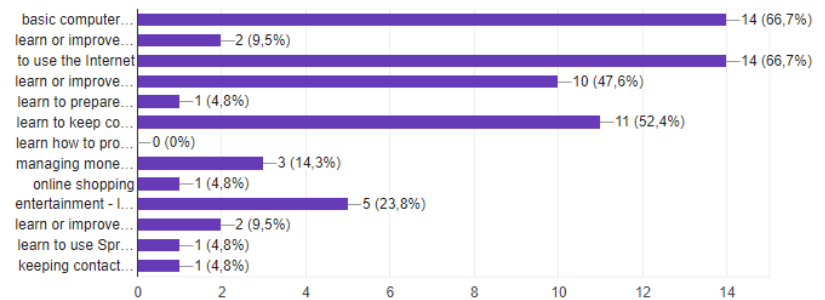
Age
